

Wiltshire Cricket Limited is seeking to employ a highly motivated, driven and competent Cricket coach to work on two new projects in Swindon. The role will be to manage and deliver on two Street Cricket projects at two separate locations in Swindon.

Part of the role's focus will be working with traditional cricket partners, such as clubs and schools, however we would also expect the role to investigate new markets and partners to help drive participation in these two new projects. With that in mind we are seeking an innovative individual who will bring enthusiasm and fresh ideas to the role.

Chance to Shine Street brings cricket to thousands of young people in inner-city areas. It uses the game to promote social cohesion and create opportunities in diverse communities affected by anti-social behaviour and youth crime. Chance to Shine believe that every child, no matter where they live, should have the opportunity to enjoy cricket. Chance to Shine Street is a counter for a lack of clubs and green spaces in inner-city areas and aims to make cricket accessible to young people throughout the country.

At sessions, young people play a fast-paced version of tape-ball cricket, using a tennis ball wrapped in electrical tape. Each innings lasts for 20 balls and games last for just 20 minutes. It needs very little cricket equipment and is ideal for inner-city or urban venues. We have identified two sites within Swindon at which we will be launching Street Cricket in 2018-2019.

Specifically the role will include:

- Delivering taster sessions in partnership with schools and local community organisations to help drive recruitment for the Street Cricket projects
- Delivering weekly Street Cricket sessions at two separate community locations in Swindon
- Delivering both intra county and inter county competition opportunities for Street Cricket participants
- Working with local cricket clubs to aid transition between Street Cricket and traditional club cricket settings
- Monitoring and evaluating all activity delivered as part of the role

We will expect candidates to hold a Level 2 cricket coaching qualification with all accompanying prerequisittres (1st Aid, Child Protection, DBS). Candidates must demonstrate both team working skills and the ability to work unsupervised using their own initiative. You will be a self-starter with energy and enthusiasm together with good administration and organisational skills. Equally you will be an excellent communicator with a passion for the development of cricket/sport for young people.
